FREE PROGRAMS & SERVICES



Resource Recovery owns and operates RI's central waste management facilities. We provide FREE facility tours, presentations, and table with info on waste reduction, reuse, recycling, composting, and proper disposal at events. We conduct FREE recycling at large community events and perform building waste assessments to help RI businesses and institutions start or improve their program.


FACILITY TOURS/FIELD TRIPS



Travel around our facility and see what happens to your stuff when it leaves the curb! You'll see our state-of-the-art Materials Recycling Facility (MRF), drop-off center, Eco-Depot, leaf & yard composting site, and go to the very top of RI's Central Landfill. Children can also explore our education center.

MaxBus Full Facility Tour: 90-minute tour for individuals or small groups who cannot arrive in their own bus or 10+ passenger van. Guests board a tour bus once on site. These tours are offered on pre-set Wednesdays and Saturdays, from late-March through early-November.

Full Facility Tour: 90-minute tours that require your group to arrive in a bus or 10+ passenger van.



You must keepone open seat for your tour guide. We can accommodate a maximum of two vehicles/tour. You can request these for a Mon.-Fri. at 9:30 AM or 11:30 AM, or a Sat. at 9:30 AM.

Materials Recycling Facility Tour: 45-minute tours of our Materials Recycling Facility are available for groups of 10+ without a bus or a van.

PRESENTATIONS/SPEAKERS



Resource Recovery educators are available to travel and speak to community groups. Topics include waste reduction, reuse, recycling, composting, and proper disposal. MaxMan, RI's Recycling Superhero, is available for events of 50+ participants and is most popular with young children and families.

EVENT RECYCLING/TABLING/APPEARANCES

Our educators can also be on hand at events hosted by RI groups at no cost. Our staff will set up an informational booth, speak with your attendees, and hand out valuable info. For events with 50+ attendees/hour, MaxMan can also make an appearance. For large events (2,000+ attendees) with volunteers, we may be able to provide recycling, too.



HELP STARTING OR IMPROVING A PROGRAM



If your building doesn't currently have a recycling program, or you believe that your program can be better, we are here to help!

Our staff will visit your location to meet with you—members, employees, custodial staff—everyone who can and should be engaged in the program. We will complete a walkthrough to determine the types of materials currently being thrown away, and help you develop an action plan to reduce your waste, including how you can adopt the state's official mixed recycling bin labels.
